The Battle of the Camel (Battle of Basra) took place at Basra, Iraq on 7 November 656 (13 Jumada Al-Awwal 36 AH). The fateful battle ended with victory for Ali and the defeat of Ayesha.

The battle played a major role in motivating Abu Bakr to complete the compilation of the Qur’an because in this battle more than 70 huffaz (Muslims who had memorized the Qur’an) were martyred and after that Abu Bakr ordered the collection of all the surviving pieces of the Qur’an into one copy and the rest be burnt.

Israel or in Hebrew Yisra-El is derived from two Hebrew root words: Yisra meaning to strive or struggle and El means God, thus the literal meaning of the Hebrew term Israel would mean he who struggles with God and with men and it was a name apparently given to Prophet Yaqoob (a.s.) after he apparently wrestled with God, as stated according to Jewish tradition and in the Bible in the Book of Genesis 32:22-32.
